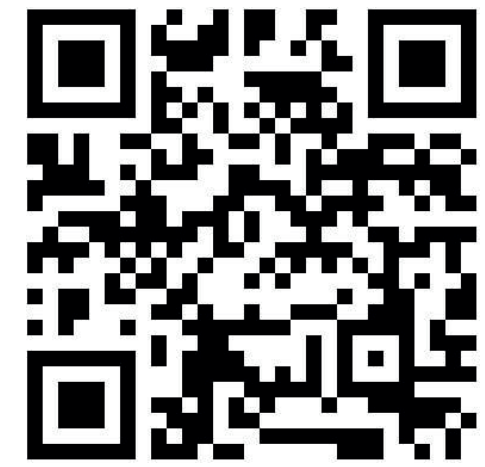
# THE CONDITIONAL CASH TRANSFER FOR EDUCATION FOR FOREIGNERS (CCTE) PROJECT

**DID YOU KNOW THAT YOU CAN BENEFIT FROM CASH ASSISTANCE FOR YOUR SCHOOL-ATTENDING CHILDREN?**



If you meet the eligibility criteria for the Conditional Cash Transfer for Education (CCTE) Project; if you have a child or children of kindergarten, primary, secondary or high school age who are enrolled in a public school and attend school regularly, you can also benefit from this project.

The payments made within the scope of the project vary depending on the age and gender of the children. You can access the details about the amount of assistance through the link that appears on your screen by pointing your phone's camera at the QR code below:



Households benefiting from the ESN and C-ESN projects and having children attending school can also apply for the CCTE Project.

## How can I apply to the Project?

You can apply by visiting the Social Assistance and Solidarity Foundation (SASF) or, if available, Türk Kızılay Service Center in your registered area.

## How are payments made within the Project?

Cash payments are calculated on a monthly basis and uploaded to your KIZILAYKART every two months, provided that your child attends school regularly during the school terms.



You can call toll-free 168 Kızılay Call Centre to request information, submit a complaint and share your feedback.
